SPANISH LANGUAGE COMMUNITY POLICE ACADEMY

The Inglewood Police Department is currently looking for interested citizens to participate in the Department's **Spanish language** Community Police Academy. The Community Academy is an 11-week academic program designed to provide interested Inglewood citizens with hand on knowledge about the various operational components of the Inglewood Police Department. Class instruction is provided by a select group of Spanish speaking subject matter experts within the Police Department. Practical learning opportunities, such as conducting field ride-along activities with patrol officers, will also be available to the participants.
